



What to bring for your Canine Pal when boarding at Green Acres K-9 Resort

1. Food:

When you bring food, bring some extra (since they will be very active) for your dog to eat while staying with us at Green Acres K-9 Resort. Please have it in spill proof containers clearly marked with your dog's name. 'Zip-lock' bags, coffee cans, and plastic containers are examples of ways owners have brought food to us. If for some reason bringing food is not an option or your food runs out, we will feed your dog our food. Currently we feed Canidae dog food. We charge market rates of \$10.00 per 10 pound bag of food.

2. Properly fitting flat soft collar with ID tag:

All dogs boarded at Green Acres K-9 Resort need to be wearing a soft flat collar that is proper in size. Chokers or training collars will be removed prior to dogs being placed in the kennel and will not be allowed on dogs when in daycare or in exercise pens. This is to prevent accidental choking and neck injuries. An ID tag with the dogs name needs to be on collars too. Please understand that the dogs will be playing outside and collars can and do become dirty, get lost or ruined at times. Therefore expensive or irreplaceable collars are not the best choices for dogs to be wearing while in our care.

ID tags and acceptable collars can be bought at Green Acres K-9 Resort if needed.

3. Bedding:

Some dogs will feel more at ease if there is an article of clothing that smells like 'home' or a familiar bed the dog uses. (Please include the dogs name on it.) Although this is not required it will make your dog's stay with us more comfortable. We make every effort to have bedding clean and dry prior to your dog returning home. Please note dog beds can become soiled, muddy or even ripped while used here.

4. Copy of current vaccines:

All dogs staying at Green Acres K-9 Resort are required to be current on vaccines considered core (universally recommended) by the AAHA and also Bordetella (Kennel Cough). These guide lines are for the well being and safety of our canine pal. Copies of vaccines are due **ONE WEEK PRIOR** to your dog's stay or at time of reservations made which ever is soonest to your dogs arrival. We reserve the right to deny boarding and daycare services to any dog that does not have current records on file at time of drop off. There will be a \$20.00 fee if our staff is required to locate these records. The records can be faxed to our office at 503.907.5520.
